**Q 1 What is Section 3?**

A1 Section 3 is where you employee a current WHA resident.

**Q2 Does the WHA currently have a Cap Quantity set by the City?**

A2 No, the WHA does not have a specific Cap quantity.

**Q3 How many Refuse pick ups at family developments per week?**

A3 Family developments have one pick up per week

**Q4 Is it a requirement the family developments are picked up on two different days per week?**

A4 Not sure, will check with maintenance foremen.

**A4 Revised** Family developments may not be picked up on the same day. Two different pick up days are required

**Q5 Is all new equipment a requirement?**

A5 Yes, new or completely refurbished equipment so the equipment appears to be new.

**Q6 Currently are the white goods and furniture segregated by separate equipment?**

A6 Yes, as much as possible.

**Q7 Will mattress pick ups be required?**

A7 Currently the WHA delivers the mattresses to the City of Woonsocket's Recycling Center.  
(It was brought up the cost to dumps mattresses by go away on May 1, 2016)

**Q8 Can a recycling program for each unit be submitted?**

A8 Submission of the requirement must be submitted and a recycling program can be submitted as an alternate.

**Q9 Are dedicated trucks a requirement?**

A9 Yes, dedicated trucks are required

**Q10 Is it possible to receive a Refuse Capacity Quantity?**

A10 No, the WHA will not provide a specific capacity quantity.

**Q11 Are dedicated trucks required for recycling?**

A11 Recycling quantities are needed to track the recycling for the City of Woonsocket

**Q12 Is there a possibility that the bid will be split between vendors?**

A12 No, the individual costs are requested for financial purposes only

**Q13 Will there be a cost of living increase for years 2 and 3?**

A13 No

**Q14 Will the WHA consider using 10 yard dumpsters in place of 8 yard dumpsters?**

A14 Yes, only if it is the same footprint

**Q15 If the WHA adds additional pickups, can the price reflect the increase in pick ups?**

A15 Yes, if it is continuous.

**Q16 Can current costs be available from current supplier?**

A16 Yes.

Recycling \$1,617 per month
